This special dance will re-live fifty years in a single evening! The dances on the program were favourites during the first half century of Scottish country dancing in Vancouver, from 1930 to 1980. We'll start with a grand march followed by an Eightsome Reel and other traditional dances which are still familiar now. Then we'll fast forward to the first modern dance to be published, the "Reel of the 51st Division," created by Scottish prisoners of war during World War II. We'll dance a classic early John Drewry dance and also one by Mary Isdale MacNab, a Vancouver deviser who was a household name in the 50s and 60s. "Rest and Be Thankful," a dance which became wildly popular here in the 70s, will be a rousing end to the evening.

If you like to dress up, wear anything from a 50s ballerina gown to a 60s miniskirt. The dance is sponsored by the Burnaby Club, and we'd appreciate small donations of food.
