#### **EVENT SAFETY BRIEFING**

#### for the

### Scottish Cultural Centre Caledonian Room (Ballroom)

### During today's/tonight's event:

- Please ensure that all shoes and bags are tucked well under the seats and do not obstruct exits or dancers.
- Please inform the MC or one of our dance briefers of slippery sections on the floor.
- Damp sponge trays are available for your use OR slip stop can be applied sparingly.

In any Emergency, the MC is the designated coordinator who will call 911 (introduce him/her).

## Please exit the building via the five (5) signed exits:

- There are three along the wall to my right:
  - > Two lead to exits at the front of building onto Hudson Street;
  - One leads to the back alley.
- The fourth exit is on the window side of the stage and leads down steps to 73rd Avenue.
- The fifth exit is the wheelchair accessible exit at the far SW corner of room via a ramp to Hudson Street.

The door to the underground parking on the lower floor is NOT a Fire Exit and may be locked.

**Our assembly point** is the parking lot diagonally across the street by the coffee shop. This is the SW corner of Hudson and 73rd Avenue.

# There are four (4) internal fire alarms on the main floor (point them out):

- Beside the door at the SW corner exit;
- Beside the door at the SE corner exit (junction of the stage and window wall);
- In the foyer on the wall between the 2 staircases;
- And in the kitchen (just behind the door to your left as you enter).

There are also alarms on the walls of the upper and lower floors.

### **Fire extinguishers** on the main floor are located:

- In the office just off the foyer;
- In the corridor between the foyer and the kitchen;
- On the stage near the exit steps;
- And two in the kitchen.

There is a telephone in the caretaker's office.

Two first aid kits are located in the RSCDS locked cupboard, third door from the stairs, on the lower level.

• The red case is for events at the SCC. The blue case is for DITP.

There are (2) AED's - Automatic External Defibulators - in the building. Both are marked AED.

- One is on the main floor, on the South side of the corridor, across from the cloakrooms.
- The other is in the Caretaker's Office.
